

In accordance with RSMo 571.107

you may not carry a concealed firearm in the following places:



- ⇒ Any law enforcement agency✳
 - ⇒ Adult or juvenile jail or institution✳
 - ⇒ Courthouse or facilities
 - ⇒ Any meeting of a governmental body✳
 - ⇒ Bar ✳
 - ⇒ Within 25 feet of any polling place on election day
 - ⇒ The secure area of an airport
 - ⇒ Anywhere prohibited by federal law
 - ⇒ Schools✳
 - ⇒ Child care facilities✳
 - ⇒ Riverboat gambling facilities✳
 - ⇒ Gated area of amusement parks✳
 - ⇒ Church or places of worship✳
- ⇒ Sports arena or stadium [with seating for more than 5000]
 - ⇒ Hospitals✳
 - ⇒ Property where legally (11" x 14"-; 1" letters) posted
 - ✳without consent of the owner, institutional head, governing board,

Possession of a firearm in a vehicle on the premises of any of the above listed locations is not prohibited as long as the firearm is not removed from the vehicle or brandished while the vehicle is on premises. Carrying a loaded firearm in any location specified above is not a criminal act. You may be denied access to the premises or may be removed for doing so.
